


Harvey Milk High School

Harvey Milk High School is a <u>public high school</u> in East Village of New York City designed for, though not limited to gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender young people, as well as those questioning their sexuality.

The school was originally run by the Hetrick-Martin Institue (HMI), an organization that provides social support to at-risk youth, especially non-heterosexuals. After becoming a fully accredited public school in 2002, the high school is now administered by the New York City Department of Education, separate from HMI. The school and the non-profit still share space in the same building, with Hetrick-Martin providing a majority of the school's arts and culture programming.






1978 ~The assassination of Mayor George Moscone

In 1978, 32-year old **former police officer Dan White quit his job as San Francisco Board supervisor,** citing person stress. In November, went to City Hall and pleaded with Mayor George Moscone to let him come back to the job. Moscone refused.





1978 ~The assassination of Mayor George Moscone

Dan White **shot Mayor Moscone 4 times, twice in the head**. He left him for dead, and went down the hall, gun in hand.





1978 ~The assassination of Harvey Milk

Dan White went to the office of his colleague, Harvey Milk, California's **first openly gay politician**. Milk had been against Dan White's reinstatement as Supervisor. Dan White **shot him 5 times**, **twice in the head**.



The aftermath

White walked out of City Hall and was arrested later that day. At the police station, in front of fellow officers, he confesses to both murders.



The city reacts...

Dianne Feinstein announced the news and took up the position of Acting Mayor. The city of San Francisco went into shock.

1979 ~ the trial

• Dan White went on **trial for murder**. His lawyer defended his actions, citing White's job stress and his "diminished capacity" because of his poor diet – the infamous "**Twinkie**" **defense**.



1979 ~ the verdict

Instead of being found guilty of murder, Dan White was charged with **voluntary manslaughter**.





1979~ the "White Night" riots

Gay activists and their allies took to the streets of San Francisco in protest.





Among the activists were "Sister Boom Boom"




Aftermath

Dan White served 5 years in jail and returned to San Francisco. He committed suicide in a parked car in 1985.

EXECUTION OF JUSTICE

In 1984, playwright/director Emily Mann was commissioned to write a play about the murders of Moscone and Milk and the trial which had divided a city— and the country.





EXECUTION OF JUSTICE

Known for her plays about real people trying to overcome the wounds of war, exile, oppression and domestic violence, Mann struggled to find the best format for the "Dan White" project.

Finding a process

Mann decided to use material from transcripts and interviews from people involved in the event



Side by side

On stage, the actors stood **side by side**, playing a range of roles and speaking directly to the audience.



"Theatre of testimony"

This landmark play was a dynamic reinvention of a form of performance called "theatre of testimony."

EXECUTION OF JUSTICE: production history

The play, <u>originally commissioned by San Francisco's Eureka</u>
Theatre, premiered at Washington, D.C.'s Arena Stage and went on to Broadway in 1986, with a cast featuring **John Spencer**, **Wesley Snipes**, **Stanley Tucci**, **Mary McDonnell**, and **Earle Hyman**.
