Benjamin Lay (January 26,1682–February 8,1759) was an English-born abolitionist, Quaker, vegetarian, sailor, farmer, animal-rights advocate, anti-racist activist, Little Person, writer and preacher.



He moved from England to Barbados, then settled in Pennsylvania in the American colonies. He was upset with his fellow Quakers owning slaves and **preached passionately against racism and slavery.**

About Us-




